Freedom of Information Request Reference No: 2013020383

Thank you for your request for information about the fatality of Philip Dodd at the Marks & Spencer store in Tunbridge Wells.

Your request was received on 12th February 2013 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act).

Under the provisions of section 14 of the Act I have decided to refuse your request as it has been deemed a "repeated request". Section 14(2) of the Act provides:

"Where a public authority has previously complied with a request for information which was made by any person, it is not obliged to comply with a subsequent identical or substantially similar request from that person unless a reasonable interval has elapsed between compliance with the previous request and the making of the current request".

Our records indicate that HSE previously complied with your current request on 4th January 2013. It is clear that a "reasonable interval" has not elapsed between your requests.

In my previous response I advised that HSE does not hold the information that you seek. Furthermore I advised you to contact Tunbridge Wells Borough Council who may hold this information. For your assistance I have enclosed a copy of my previous correspondence.

If you are unhappy with the decisions made by HSE you may ask for an internal review within two calendar months of the date of this letter by writing to me.
